



Careers Link Governor - Role and Responsibilities

Link governors should focus on a specific aspect of school life and report back to the LGB on it. Their job is to raise the profile of the issue, monitor it, and provide support and challenge to key school staff. The careers link governor will:

- 1) Ensure that the responsibilities of the Local Governing Body (LGB) are discharged regarding careers information, advice and guidance (IAG) and liaison.
- 2) Ensure that progress is maintained towards meeting every aspect of the Gatsby benchmark.
- 3) Receive reports on careers IAG provision and progress from the Careers Lead, and report progress to the LGB.
- 4) Actively support school staff in all aspects of careers IAG, encounters with employers, and interview training through liaison with local businesses and organisations.
- 5) Advocate at the LGB, in discussion of strategic goals, the importance of NEET targets to our mission.
- 6) Ensure that the SLT provides appropriate resources to careers IAG.
- 7) Ensure that the school's website includes up-to-date training provider access information, including the name, email address and contact number of the school's Careers Lead.
