



Performance Data Link Governor - Role and Responsibilities

Link governors should focus on a specific aspect of school life and report back to the LGB on it. Their job is to raise the profile of the issue, monitor it, and provide support and challenge to key school staff. The performance data link governor will:

- 1) Scrutinise pupil progress and attainment data and brief the LGB accordingly each term, always recognising that additional care is needed in interpreting data relating to small groups with diverse challenges.
- 2) With the guidance of the Headteacher, advise the LGB in its setting of appropriately challenging targets, focussed on improving pupil progress, for the Academy Development Plan (ADP).
- 3) With the Headteacher, prepare a brief summary of performance trends for the school year for inclusion in the LGB annual review. This summary should seek to provide evidence of the impact of strategic plans implemented.
