



### **SEND Governor - Role and Responsibilities**

Link governors should focus on a specific aspect of school life and report back to the LGB on it. Their job is to raise the profile of the issue, monitor it, and provide support and challenge to key school staff. The SEND link governor will:

- 1) To ensure that the responsibilities of the Local Governing Body (LGB) are discharged regarding pupils with SEND.
- 2) To ensure that funding, income and expenditure is used effectively and efficiently to support SEND within the school and that the LGB are kept informed of this.
- 3) To receive reports on standards and attainment from the SLT and/or SENCO.
- 4) To meet termly with members of the SLT and/or SENCO to discuss the implementation and impact of current policies and practices on the progress of pupils with SEND and to monitor that achievement gaps are being closed.
- 5) To contribute to strategic planning for future improvements to enhance the progress of pupils with SEND by liaising with SLT and advising the LGB.
- 6) To ensure that the SLT completes and submits an Annual Audit to the LGB.
- 7) To provide information on the quality and effectiveness of SEND provision within the school to the LGB.
- 8) To ensure that the school's website publishes the school's SEND policy.
