

# SSS

## Onsite Learning

### Permanently Excluded KS3

All pupils who attend The Quay School @ Harbourside come through SSS and complete an initial assessment, work is tailored to individual need based on this assessment plus teacher judgement and any information from outside agencies.

### Literacy, Humanities, Science and Art

All these subjects are taught through a topic based curriculum, the topic changes each half term

### Maths

Maths is taught explicitly and follows the KS3 curriculum, adapted for individual need

### Wellbeing

Wellbeing covers PSD topics that are relevant to our pupils, as well as emotional literacy and work from the "talkabout" programme.

### Intervention

Any pupils who need any extra support in either literacy, numeracy or emotional literacy will be offered targeted and specific 1:1 intervention to support in these areas



### Emotional and Behavioural Development

Emotional Literacy is embedded throughout the curriculum and each group has a 'wellbeing' session included in their onsite timetable. Pupils also spend breakfast, break and lunchtime with staff in order to develop social skills and positive social interaction. All pupils complete behaviour mentoring.

### Offsite provision

Pupils spend two days a week offsite, literacy, numeracy and emotional literacy are embedded throughout the curriculum

### ASDAN (personal development)

Covers a range of activities from bush craft and survival skills, to communication and the community

### OAA

Outdoor adventurous activities, including indoor and outdoor climbing, paddle sports, mountain biking, indoor skiing and archery

### Duke of Edinburgh

Physical & skills activities as above with volunteering and an expedition

### Enrichment

On Fridays all pupils are offered a range of enrichment activities to take part in, including; motor mechanics, catering, hair and beauty, arts and crafts and sport



## Outcomes

### ASDAN Bronze Award

Pupils who spend the academic year in SSS should be able to achieve enough credits to entitle them to the ASDAN Bronze Award

### AQA Unit Award

AQA Unit Awards are offered in OAA and Enrichment Activities

### Functional Skills Literacy and Numeracy

Each year SSS has three exam weeks where pupils are able to attain Functional Skills qualifications in Literacy and Numeracy

### Duke of Edinburgh Bronze Award

Pupils who spend the academic year with us should be able to achieve the DOE Bronze Award

The aim for all KS3 pupils who attend SSS is to return to mainstream school. This is supported by our School Transition Mentor. Those pupils unable to return to mainstream school will be supported to be in a better place to access our vocational curriculum in KS4
