Home School

a) Long stay (5+days)

Contact made with home school by staff with permission from parents

b) Repeated short admissions

KS1-4 – facilitated school work provided by a YP own school.

Short stay (less than 5 days)

Targeted work based on theme of the day.

Activities tailored to individual needs and abilities following initial assessment.

Well Being

Social interaction and engagement

Literacy and Numeracy

Literacy focus each day to include 15 minutes reading

Numeracy focus each day to include 10 minutes times tables or mental maths

Enrichment and well being

PSHCE, Science, Art, Humanities, ICT, rights respecting, crafts, games, PE.

Medical and educational liaison:

Communication with medical staff
Oncology MDT meetings
Daily briefings
Communication with play specialist
Contact with schools and other agencies

Outcomes

YP are able to keep up with their Home School work.

GCSE, BTEC, KS3, KS2.
KS1, reception
